- 1) Below are the directions for Clare Estate in Bordentown and the call time. ***There is no refresher rehearsal for the Clare Estate concert.*** It will be more casual than our public performances.
- 2) There will be a refresher rehearsal for the Millstone Concert. This is a very important concert and we really need to be on top of things. The ***refresher will be on Friday, May 2nd, 6:00 AUMC*** to review the music and to work our singing quality. It will be important to attend this. Please mark your calendar. If you cannot attend on Friday, ***There will be an alternate time on Thursday, May 1st at 6:00 p.m.*** at AUMC. ***Please let me know which refresher you will attend.***

Clare Estates 201 Crosswicks St., Bordentown, NJ 08505

Below are the Map Quest directions to Clare Estates from the Allentown United Methodist Church. It will take about 12 minutes from there.

Crosswicks Street is at the top of the hill in Bordentown while traveling south on RT 130/206 S. Turn right by the gas station, (used to be Exxon - now I think is Liberty), and Clare Estates is on the right.

See you Sunday. We are scheduled to sing at 6 p.m. Let's gather at 5:30 to warm-up and figure out the details. WEAR YOUR CONCERT ATTIRE PLEASE.

1: Start out going 1.0 miles
NORTHWEST on CHURCH
ST / CR-526 toward
HAMILTON ST. Continue to
follow CR-526.

2: Merge onto I-195 W toward 2.6 miles
NEW JERSEY TURNPIKE.

3: Merge onto US-130 S via 5.7 miles
EXIT 5A toward
BORDENTOWN.

4: Turn RIGHT onto <0.1 miles
CROSSWICKS ST / CR-528.

5: End at **201 Crosswicks St**
Bordentown, NJ 08505-1740, US
