**Millstone Interfaith Quiet Fund  
Feature Charity of Community Christian Choir,  
Sand Artist and Art Contest Winners**

May 6, 2008 – Sunday, May 4th brought the Community Christian Choir to the Millstone Performing Arts Center in Perrineville, NJ in their second concert of their 27<sup>th</sup> season. Their program titled “Center-Peace” featured their full choir and a special artist, Mark Demel, a sand artist from Chicago, Illinois. A benefit concert for Millstone Interfaith Quiet Fund, the concert raised over \$800 will be used to by the Interfaith Counsel to aid families who, through no fault of their own, were suffering financial struggles

Demel, an artist that has been featured at many Christian gatherings and concerts, drew with sprays of sand, many different images including Christ on the cross, a whale, a swan, a candle and many others. It was thrilling for the audience to see the images appear on the screen behind the choir as it was singing. Demel created the images to appear and supplement the text of the music.

Another featured activity of the concert was the presentation of the winners of the “Center-Peace” Art and Writing Contest. With over 50 entrants in the contest, 14 winners were named prior to the concert and certificates and ribbons were awarded.

The Community Christian Choir is a multi-denominational choir with over 130 members ranging in age from 5 to Adult.
