### **COMMUNITY CHRISTIAN CHOIR CONCERT BENEFITS SUNSHINE FOUNDATION AND ITS CHILDREN**

**March 19, 2008** - At its final concert of the 2007 season on December 16th, the Community Christian Choir, a multi-denominational contemporary Christian choir of over 130 voices – ages 5 to Adult, sang for the benefit of Sunshine Foundation, a foundation that benefits families of sick children. Singing to a crowd of over 600 people at Millstone Performing Arts Center in Perrineville, NJ, the CCC presented their winter program “More Than a Story”, a festival of song centering on the Christmas message.

“Having raised over \$115,000 for charities in the Central New Jersey region over the last 26 seasons, the CCC was honored to sing for the benefit of Sunshine Foundation,” said Pat Weitz, director. “Sunshine Foundation does such a worthy work in helping families devastated by a child’s illness. They answer the dreams of the sick child as well as the families. Just hearing what they do and who they do it for, touches your heart.”

All proceeds from the concert by the CCC go to the designated charity. At this concert, \$1,100 was raised through a good-will offering. Past charities have been HomeFront, Habitat for Humanity, Families In Transition, St. Vincent DePaul Society and many more. Presentation of the donated funds was made on March 1, 2008.

The Community Christian Choir begins its 27<sup>th</sup> season of concerts on April 20<sup>th</sup> with their “Center-Peace” program at the Robbinsville Seventh Day Adventist Church.
