## ALPHA

6 yrs. old - 3 rd grade \* Rehearse Sunday afternoon  
Willingness to participate in movement activities  
Ability to match pitch & carry a tune within a group  
Appropriate behavior is expected

## DISCIPLES

4th. - 6th. Grade \* Rehearse Sunday afternoon  
Ability to match pitch & sing in head voice  
*A great place for singers to enjoy a successful choir experience  
without the demands of the Credo & Legacy levels*

## APOSTLES

Teens - 7th grade and up Rehearse Sunday afternoon/evening  
Ability to match pitch  
*A great place for singers to enjoy a successful choir experience  
without the demands of the Credo & Legacy levels*

## CREDO

6th. Grade & Up (*by audition only*) \* Rehearse Sunday evening  
Ability to sing in tune, blend voice with group,  
maintain harmony part alone or with a group  
Willingness to accept instruction & read music  
High singer commitment level & parent commitment required

## LEGACY

7th. Grade & Up (*by audition only*) \* Rehearse Sunday evening  
Professional Level Youth Choir  
Extremely accomplished singing & musicianship skills  
Willingness to accept instruction & read music fluently  
Rarely misses rehearsals & other scheduled events  
Extremely high singer commitment level & parent commitment required
